### SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Before joining HMF, Dr. Abrahamian was an associate physician in the department of allergy and clinical immunology for Kaiser Permanente in Downey.

She treated both children and adults for common disorders such as allergic rhinitis, asthma, eczema, and food allergies. She conducted skin testing and immunotherapy (allergy shots) to desensitize patients from their environmental

allergies. She also diagnosed and treated more complex conditions like hereditary angioedema and common variable immunodeficiency.
